SUBJECT: To Amend Bylaws 4.2.2; 8.4.1, and Insert Bylaws 8.3.5-8.3.6.1 for "Housekeeping, Procedural, or Improving Functionality" Purposes

for housekeeping, procedural, or improvement in functionality at the November

2, 2020 meeting for consideration by the 2021 District Convention; and

The rationales for all of these proposals are included with the proposed bylaws in WHEREAS,

The Synod's Commission on Constitutional Matters reviewed the proposed WHEREAS,

bylaws at their January 15-16, 2021 meeting and found the proposal to be consistent with the Constitution and Bylaws of the Synod and gave their approval for the District Convention's consideration in Opinion 20-2958; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That Mid-South District Bylaw 4.2.2 be amended as proposed to allow for an

optional non-voting recording secretary, rather than require one to be appointed,

to assist the district secretary if needed; and be it further

RESOLVED, That Mid-South District Bylaw 8.4.1 be amended as proposed to eliminate term

limits for the district secretary and district treasurer, mirroring no term limits of these offices in the Synod, yet always giving the convention delegates the choice in electing a district secretary, or the Board of Directors its choice in renewing an

appointment or appointing a new district treasurer; and be it finally

RESOLVED, That the Mid-South District Bylaws be amended by inserting proposed Bylaws

8.3.5-8.3.6.1, adding in their corresponding headings above Bylaw 8.3, and

renumbering current Bylaws 8.3.5-8.3.5.5 to 8.3.7-8.3.7.5.
